

- b) It is not possible to shape a child's character for the better by teaching them at school they will simply pick these things up from their peers and their experiences at school





Do you think that schools should have a statement of the core character traits that it aims to develop in its students?




Nearly nine-in-ten parents think that schools have a wider role to play than just delivering academic results
