

CARING FOR OUR SCHOOL

SESSION B



Caring is:

- * Doing your very best with your school work, or with a job that you've been asked to do.
- * Giving attention to someone who needs help or is sad.
- * Looking after yourself by eating the right things and keeping yourself clean.
- * Ensuring that we do not damage the natural environment.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

To understand that the school and its environment should be cared for.

Suggested Resources:

Recording equipment such as a USB recorder, IPAD or tablet with a recording app, or a mobile phone with voice recorder.

Script:

“In the last lesson we created an imaginary letter from the school so that it could let people know that it felt uncared for. This week we are going to use that letter and work in twos or threes to create a radio interview with the school. This will be recorded and played to the other classes in our school to help them understand that our school needs care too.”

Suggested Activities:

Role play: Children work in pairs with one partner taking the part of a reporter from ‘Caring Radio’ who

Use these phrases to encourage an attitude of caring in your interactions with children in your class and around the school.

Guidance:

How could we show caring for children who are new to the school?

conducts an interview with the other child who acts as the voice of the school. Children could use their own letters created in the previous week as the basis of a script.

Alternative Activities:

Script Writing: Children write an imaginary interview with the school using the letter from last week as the basis of the script.

Report Writing: Children walk around the school and write reports including digital photographs to show areas of the school that need more care.

Plenary:

Children listen to a selection of interviews and choose one or two examples that they think best explain the school's need for care.

Meaningful Praise:

I am pleased to see you caring for the school/ environment by turning off the lights/picking up litter etc.

Correction:

If you tidy up after you have been working, how does that show care towards others?
