LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

To be able to apply the skills for introductions and asking questions.

Script:

“It is important that we get to know other people in our school as many of them could be our friends and we all belong to the school community. Today, each of you will be ‘buddying’ with another pupil in a different class and year group. You will be learning all about them and they will be learning about you.”

Meaningful Praise:

It was really pleasing to see how friendly you were with the other children today. You showed great confidence.

Suggested Activities:

Buddy each of the children up with a child from the other year group. Give the children some time together to ask each other questions and find out some interesting facts about them. Once they have completed this, the children will then work in pairs to introduce themselves and each other to the rest of the pupils. You may want to split the classes in half to save time on presenting.

Plenary

Watch the short video clip and recap with the children what they have learned about the topic.

Guidance:

Think about how you felt today when you were introduced by your partner to the rest of the class. Remember that this is how a person feels when you are friendly towards them.
