REFLECTING ON GRAFITUDE



SESSION B

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

To be able to answer questions about the good things that have happened in their lives; to reflect on who enabled these good things to happen.

Suggested Resources:

Clipboards, with print-out of questions, and writing paper for children to take notes.

Script:

This lesson builds on the previous lesson. See last week's lesson plan for a recap of the circle session. You may use this time to address issues that children had during their interviews last week.

Suggested Activities:

In the same pairs as the last week, children should swap roles as interviewer and interviewee. Follow the same format as last week, giving pairs of children time, space and the clipboards to interview their partner. Ensure there is some time for the interviewers to feedback to the whole class at the end of the lesson.
