TELLING THE WHOLE TRUTH SESSION B

Honesty is:

- * Speaking the truth.
- * Refusing to cheat or take something that does not belong to you.
- * Admitting your mistakes.
- * Being true to yourself.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

Children know that hiding the truth, even if nothing is said (deceiving), is dishonest. Children know that being honest means telling the whole truth.

Preparation:

Have children in pre-arranged groups of five in preparation for today's role play activity.

Script:

"Last week we shared the scenario of someone who is not truthful about where they are and who they are with. Using the scripts you created last week and in the roles you chose for yourself - (mum, dad, Zara, Sam, etc.) prepare a simple role play of the events to share with the class."
