


SPORT...

JUDY GUINNESS FENCING, OLYMPICS (1932)

AT THE 1932 OLYMPICS IN LOS ANGELES, JUDY GUINNESS STOOD TO BECOME THE FIRST EVER BRITON TO WIN FENCING GOLD. SHE WAS JUST 21 YEARS OLD. AFTER A CLOSELY CONTESTED FINAL AGAINST AUSTRIAN ELLEN PREIS, GUINNESS WAS DECLARED THE WINNER BY THE JUDGES, BUT SHE POINTED OUT TO THEM THAT THEY HAD MISSED TWO HITS BY HER OPPONENT. GUINNESS' HONESTY MEANT THAT HER RIVAL WAS AWARDED THE GOLD MEDAL, AND SHE THE SILVER.

WHAT WOULD YOU DO?

DILEMMA 1

HOWEVER, KLOSE RAN TO THE REFEREE AND TOLD HIM THE BALL HAD TOUCHED HIS HAND ON THE WAY TO THE GOAL. THE GOAL WAS NOT ALLOWED.

DILEMMA 2


YOU ARE PLAYING FOOTBALL. THE SCORES ARE LEVEL AND IT IS NEARLY FULL TIME. THE GOALIE GETS INJURED CLEARING THE BALL AND HE FALLS TO THE FLOOR. THE BALL LANDS AT YOUR FEET.

WITH THE SCORE TIED AT 1-1 AND THE MATCH DRIFTING INTO INJURY TIME, WEST HAM PLAYER PAOLO DI CANIO HAD THE CHANCE TO SHOOT INTO AN EMPTY NET AS A CROSS CAME IN FROM THE RIGHT WING. INSTEAD HE CAUGHT THE BALL, HAVING SPOTTED THAT THE EVERTON GOALKEEPER PAUL GERRARD WAS LYING ON THE GROUND INJURED. THE GAME ENDED 1-1.

DILEMMA 3


IN A SIGN OF GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP, YOU THROW THE BALL BACK TO THE OPPOSITION GOALIE AFTER HE HAS KICKED IT OUT FOR AN INJURED PLAYER. IT BOUNCES OVER THE GOALIE'S FOOT AND INTO THE EMPTY NET.

DONCASTER ROVERS PLAYER HARRY FORRESTER TRIED TO RETURN THE BALL TO OPPOSING GOALKEEPER CHRISTIAN WALTON, WHO HAD KNOCKED IT OUT OF PLAY FOLLOWING AN INJURY, BUT THE BALL WENT INTO THE BURY NET. RATHER THAN TAKE ADVANTAGE, DONCASTER ALLOWED LEON CLARKE TO WALK HALF THE LENGTH OF THE PITCH UNCHALLENGED BEFORE SCORING AN EQUALISER.
