<p><b>Y6: Democracy</b> L3 - Taking part in a democracy</p>	<p><b>Learning objective:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Identify and practice taking participating in a democracy.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Key vocabulary:</b> Democracy, campaigning, protesting, jury service, voting, petition</p> <p><b>Key virtues:</b> Respect, participation, community awareness</p>
<p><b>Resources:</b></p> <p>PowerPoint</p>	<p><b>Statutory links:</b> Citizenship (non-statutory guidance 2015) Pupils should be taught:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- What democracy is and about the basic institutions that support it locally and nationally.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Key questions:</b></p> <p>How can we participate in democracy?</p> <p>What ways can young people participate in democracy?</p> <p>What issues are important in your local community?</p> <p>What can you do about them?</p>	<p><b>Learning activities:</b></p> <p><b>Starter:</b> Taking part</p> <p>Democracy only works if ordinary people participate.</p> <p>What are the different ways that people can participate in democracy? Create a brainstorm on the board.</p> <p>Which of these can young people be involved in?</p> <p>You could give children a selection of picture prompts showing people taking part in some of the activities such as voting, protesting, signing petitions, campaigning and writing to your MP.</p> <p>You may also want to look at the youth parliament website: <a href="http://www.ukyouthparliament.org.uk/">http://www.ukyouthparliament.org.uk/</a> [accessed 29.05.2020] or local opportunities for children to participate in politics.</p> <p><b>Activity 1:</b> Moral dilemma</p> <p>Look at the moral dilemma individually and then discuss ideas in pairs before feeding back to the class.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- What is the problem?</li> <li>- How would you feel?</li> <li>- Are there any virtues in conflict in this dilemma?</li> <li>- What do you think a 'wise' solution is? Is there more than one?</li> </ul>
